Attendance

Prompt and regular attendance is required. As time is of the essence, each rehearsal is very important. Please be sure you have no conflicts in your schedule. Campers are expected to attend all camp nights (unless ill) and remain until dismissal. When a camper misses a rehearsal or leaves early it affects the entire cast.

Campers will break for dinner each night from 6-6:30; if your child has any dietary restrictions, please make sure you have noted it in the forms attached.

Schedule

All rehearsals will be held at the Weekapaug Chapel, unless otherwise noted. On Mondays the children will be permitted to leave at 7:00 to play **Bingo** at the Yacht Club.

Refund Policy

There will be no refunds for children who withdraw after the start of camp. Withdrawals made before that time are subject to a \$50 non-refundable administrative fee.

Auditions

While roles vary in size, the script has been crafted to give each child in the senior camp a meaningful part. We will be holding **auditions on the first night of camp** and giving out the parts the next day. We work to make this a positive experience for our campers; if you have any questions or concerns, please do not hesitate to contact us.

Junior Camp

The Junior Camp is for children ages 6-8. Junior campers do not try-out for parts, but rather are assigned roles which allow them several opportunities to have individual lines and be onstage. Junior Camp will run from **4:30 to 6:30 p.m.** Please make sure your junior campers are **picked up by 6:30**, as their counselors will be off duty at that time. We cannot be responsible for them after this time.

Cooperation and respect

The children are expected to work cooperatively with the staff and other campers. The staff works to model positive behavior and assist in the most helpful ways possible when campers are in need of assistance. We reserve the right to expel a camper who is excessively disruptive. Our sponsor, the Weekapaug Chapel Society, requests that the children treat the building and Memorial Garden with care and respect. We will review the guidelines for use of the chapel and garden on the first day of camp.

Items/Costume pieces from home

Traditionally, in addition to costume pieces furnished by camp, campers are asked to provide a few basic costume items from home. These are generally easy to find things, such as t-shirts, dark shorts or pants, specific shoes. After the show is cast, we will send out a costume list notifying families of these items. If you have any difficulty in providing a requested item, please let us know and we will be happy to assist. Campers are asked to bring in any items from home for the dress rehearsal (the last Thursday of camp) and the performance night (the last Friday of camp.)

Performance Night

The final Friday of camp is performance night! There will be 2 performances: 5:00 and 7:00 pm – we ask that everyone be considerate in seating. There have been years when we have not been able to seat all who wanted to attend. Although it is not required, we ask families to consider choosing either the 5 or the 7.

For both sessions, Senior Campers should plan to be at the Chapel at **3:30 pm**. Junior Campers should arrive at **4:00 pm**.

For hygienic purposes, all costumes are stored in separate plastic bags (provided by camp). We ask that campers come with their hair already done (details to follow, but usually braids or ponytails). We want to avoid anyone sharing brushes, combs or other personal items. We also ask that campers bring a change of clothes or a large shirt to wear over their costumes for the supper break between performances.

Cast Party

There will be a cast party for all the cast members and their families after the 7:00 show. Details TBD. In the past, the Yacht Club has been used for the cast party. This is not possible in July of this year since it is a fundraising year for the WYC and the clubhouse is needed the night after our July performance. If your family is willing to host the cast party in your yard, we would greatly appreciate the venue. This is a pot-luck party, and everyone is encouraged to bring a snack or drink to share.
